COVID REMINDERS

The school is required to implement strategies to ensure the health and well-being of everyone who attends/visits our school. At Athol Road Primary School these strategies include:

- Restricting all visits to the school to only those which are necessary
 - \circ $\;$ Paying fees, purchasing uniform, attending scheduled meetings
 - o Dropping children at the school gate in the morning
 - \circ $\;$ Waiting in the designated spots in the afternoons for children to be dismissed
 - \circ Complying with school requests as outlined on Sentral and in the newsletter
- Wearing of masks by adults when on school grounds
- Social distancing of 1.5 metres
- Regular hand sanitisation

STUDENT ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL ARRANGEMENTS

SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR <u>ARRIVAL</u>: YEAR 1 - 6 STUDENTS IN TERM 1

Students in Year 1 - 6 should continue to be dropped off at the school gate by 8.50am unless there is a need for a parent to come to the office OR speak to a teacher. Students managed this magnificently last year and it greatly helped with settling in and an early start to learning for the day

SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR <u>DISMISSAL</u>: YEAR 1 - 6 STUDENTS IN TERM 1

Year 3 - 6 students will be <u>dismissed from their learning spaces</u> - parents are asked to <u>wait outside the school grounds</u> for students who are being picked up. Students will cross the crossing safely with the crossing man.

Year 1/2 students will be dismissed from the front oval - parents are asked to wait on the front oval

FOUNDATION students will be <u>handed over</u> to teachers and <u>dismissed</u> by teachers at the end of the day <u>on the front basketball</u> <u>court.</u>

NOTE: Students should NOT arrive at school prior to 8.30am UNLESS they need to attend Breakfast Club

THANK YOU for your cooperation in keeping everyone as safe as possible in Term 1. These arrangements will be reviewed for Term 2.

HOME/SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP

REGULAR school attendance is essential for every student to learn! EVERY absence impacts your child's learning. Any student who exceeds 10 days absence in a term, 40 days absence in a year is considered to be at risk in their learning and may have to be considered to repeat that year. Students should be at school by 8.50am each day.

LATENESS, not only impacts the learning of your child but the learning of others. Please ensure that your child arrives at school on time every day. Already there has been a large number of students coming late!

HOMEWORK:

Teachers will be working closely with parents in 2021 to ensure that work set to be completed at home (Homework) is closely linked to student learning needs. Teachers will be using online platforms to deliver much of the learning.

EXPECTATIONS:

EVERY student should be:

- reading EVERY night!
- practising their tables **EVERY NIGHT**, finding numbers in their environment and playing number games
- engaging in **ORAL** conversation about their day, the things that interest them and impact their world conversation is essential to build langage. It does NOT have to be in English, can be in the child's home language
- focusing on a particular aspect of their work for improvement this work will be set by the teachers and specific to the student's particular point of need.
